1. All Scholarship Applicants MUST:

- a. Complete all parts of this application carefully.
Would you please type or fill it out in ink? All information will be treated as confidential.
- b. Obtain letters of recommendation from the cheerleader sponsor and the school principal. The character of the applicant must be above reproach.
- c. Submit completed application, transcript, and letters of Recommendation from principal and sponsor by October 22, 2021. Incomplete applications and applications received after this date will not be considered.
- d. Submit a photograph with the application.
- e. Attach a 200-word essay, "How has cheerleading helped me grow into the person I am today?"

2. All Scholarship Applicants should:

- a. Rank in the top 15 percent of their graduating class.

3. The high school counselor or principal must submit section V of this application.

4. The recipient of the \$700 scholarship will be announced at our KHSSA 13th Regional Cheer Competition in November.
